CAVRN is Here!

You've waited patiently, and we are excited to share the Certified Acute-Care Virtual Registered Nurse (CAVRN) credential officially launched this month! MSNCB acknowledges the significant presence of medical-surgical nurses in acute-care spaces and has developed the CAVRN in anticipation of the emerging field of acute-care telehealth. The CAVRN certification measures the competencies required to provide the virtual nursing model of care in acute-care environments. It does not test nursing knowledge in any specific specialty area and thus is available to nurses within and outside of the medical-surgical setting, or in other nursing specialties!

CAVRN Eligibility Requirements

The CAVRN certification is for nurses working exclusively or primarily in remote capacities in acute-care settings. You are eligible for the CAVRN as long as your work influences patients, nurses and/or organizations to have a positive impact on the virtual care delivered to acutely ill patients, even if you are not providing direct patient care. Nurses working in telehealth outside of acute-care settings are not eligible.

You must meet the following eligibility requirements at the time you apply for the exam and for the full 90-day test period.

• **License**. You must hold an unencumbered and current license as a Registered Nurse (RN) in the United States and its territories.

• Hours of practice. You must have worked 1,000 practice hours within the past two (2) years in a virtual acute-care setting. Practice may be as a clinical nurse, as a manager, or as an educator.
