MSNCB has also updated our eligibility requirements, making the two-year work experience requirement now a recommendation. This allows more medical-surgical nurses the opportunity to earn their certification. See below for an overview of updated requirements:

- You must hold an unencumbered and current license as a Registered Nurse (RN) in the United States, its territories, or Canada; or an international equivalent.
- You must have worked 2,000 practice hours within the past three (3) years in a medical-surgical setting. Practice may be as a clinical nurse, as a manager, or as an educator.
