Our audience engages best with pieces that do the following:

- Engage the audience through engaging and conversational styles and positive personal experiences.
- Point to new knowledge or relevant AMSN resources that impact everyday clinical practice, citing all relevant sources in APA format as appropriate.
- Consider how diversity, equity, and inclusion impact patients and nursing care relating to the topic of discussion as appropriate.

We ask that writers refrain from:

- Significant use of highly technical language, considering that AMSN has specialized forums for the dissemination of rigorous, peer-reviewed research.
- Quoting copyrighted materials.
- Making reference to specific workplaces (i.e., hospital name) or any other sensitive or protected patient or staff information.

Please consider the following guidelines when drafting and submitting your piece:

- *Monitor* articles can be 700-900 words in length.
 - If your article is outside the suggested word count, please contact the *Monitor* staff team, as there is flexibility depending on the topic or author need.
- Please attach your article to an email in the form of a Word document.
- Please include a high-quality headshot and short bio for each author in the byline.
- Your article can include photos, images, tables, etc., to enhance your message.
 - Please do not submit imagery that you do not have the rights to use.
- Content must be informational and/or educational. Content may not be overly promotional of a product or service.
- The *Monitor* content manager and volunteer editorial leadership reserves the right to revise articles fit to AMSN's style and voice.
